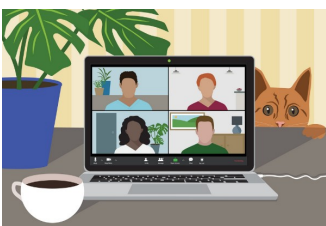
Welcome

BOOK STALL NEXT SUNDAY "Cuppa Time Reflections" by Father Martin from St Kevins, a selection of his weekly reflections as printed in the church's weekly Bulletin. Christopher Cooper edited and oversaw its printing. The reflections are mostly of a general Christian nature with very little that is specifically Catholic. The cost is \$20. \$10 from each book sale will go to a project in Uganda that Chris' friend Marissa from St Kevins is administering. A few years ago Father Fabius, a parish priest in Uganda, came to St Kevins for several months. Later, Marissa visited him and saw his parish school. On her return she started fund-raising and raised enough to set up an out-door kitchen to supply school meals. The latest project is to replace the school's 3 crumbling pit latrines.
